TRAINING REPORT ON

NURSERY MANAGEMENT AND LOW COST VERMICOMPOSTING

Forest Research Center for Livelihood Extension organized training cum workshop programme “**Nursery Management and Low Cost vermicomposting**” on the 14th March, 2023 at office campus. The participants were from different villages namely Kalashi, Das para, North Hicha chara, Daluchara in South Tripura district. The training programme started with welcome address by Shri Niren Das, ACTO and Training Coordinator, ICFRE-LEC, Agartala and followed by the introduction of 20 participants. Sh. Das, in his opening remarks, highlighted the importance of vermicomposting and mentioned that there is a growing realization now that the adoption of economical, eco-friendly and sustainable farming practices can improve productivity and contribute to environmental protection. Shri Debasish Chakraborty, Retd. IFS and President of a NGO Development Initiative for Sustainable Advancement (DISA) and also the Chairperson of Bhavan’s Tripura Vidyamandir graced the occasion as the Chief Guest. Shri Chakraborty interacted with the participants and suggested to install a unit of vermicomposting at their localities in community basis with the help of ICFRE-LEC Agartala.

During the training period, the technical details on Vermicomposting techniques involving construction of bamboo vermicomposting unit and its establishment using locally available resources were practically demonstrated. The practical demonstration was also held for application of vermicompost and vermibed wash in nursery management. An interaction session was also held with the participants and taken participants’ feedback. Training comes to an end with the distribution of certificates to the participants.
