# Significant Research Findings

#### Institute of Forest Genetic and Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- One new species of grasshopper, *Phaneroptera rentzi* (Tettigoniidae: Orthoptera) has been described and accepted for publication in Zootaxa, deposited in Zoobank.
- IFGTB has developed two interspecific hybrid clones of Eucalyptus (E. camaldulensis x E. tereticornis) for public release. These clones have been found superior than the clones released earlier by IFGTB and also the widely planted

commercial clones in terms of growth and pulp yield. These clones have been recommended by the Regional Variety Testing Committee of IFGTB to the Variety Releasing Committee (VRC) of ICFRE on 25 September 2020. The new clones are expected to further increase the productivity of *Eucalyptus* plantations in the country mainly benefiting the forest development corporations, wood-based industries and tree farmers.

#### **Consultancy**

ICFRE is presently working on ten consultancy projects, which are awarded by Tehri Hydro Development Corporation India Ltd; Himachal Pradesh Power Corporation Limited; Karnataka State Official Authority; MoEF&CC, Gol, New Delhi; Coal India Limited, Kolkata; NTPC Ltd. Noida; NMDC Ltd., Hyderabad; Singreni Collieries Company Ltd., Kothagudem; Chhattisgarh Forest Department, Raipur; Deptt. of Forest and Environment, Bhubaneswar.
