## Significant Research Findings

### ICFRE- Forest Research Institute, Dehradun

- Species has been identified and nomenclature updated for 50 species in Kanjilal's Forest Flora Chakrata, Dehradun Saharanpur Forest Division Uttar Pradesh and 60 species for Osmaston's Forest Flora for Kumaon.
- Morphological characters of *Ochlandra travancorica* has been collected and analyzed from FRI *Bambusetum* and Botanical garden. DNA Barcoding done with four primers NdhF1R1, NdhF2R2, atp F-H, PsbK-I for *Bambusa vulgaris var. striata*, *Bambusa vulgaris var. wamin*, *Dendrocalamus longispathus*, *Dendrocalamus membranaceus*.
- Successful amplication of DNA samples of *Angelica glauca* and *Gentiana kuru* with barcoding marker trnl c-f was carried out. Optimization of bar-coding marker mat K with *A. glauca*, *G. kuru* and *Malaxis acuminata* at different temperature was carried out.

### ICFRE- Institute of Forest Productivity, Ranchi

- Eco distribution mapping of 8 species viz., *Terminalia alata*, *Pterocarpus marsupium*, *Anogeissus latifolia*, *Diospyros melanoxylon*, *Buchanania cochinchinensis*, *Shorea robusta*, *Lagerstroemia parviflora*, and *Madhuca latifolia* has been completed for West Bengal state through the MaxEnt Model.

### ICFRE- Rain Forest Research Institute, Jorhat

- A total of 1775 individual pollinators belonging to 129 species (*Lepidoptera*-124, *Hymenoptera*-3 and *Diptera* -2) is encountered in Dihing Patkai National Park.

### ICFRE- Tropical Forest Research Institute, Jabalpur

- During the field survey, an average disease incidence ranging from 35% to 45% was noted. The predominant diseases identified including pink leaf spot affecting *Madhuca Longifolia*, *Alternaria* leaf spot affecting *Ficus* sp, leaf blight affecting *Dalbergia Longifolia* and *D.sisso*, leaf spot and dieback affecting Neem, *Bipolaris* leaf spot affecting Bamboo sp., rust affecting *Phyllanthus emblica*, *Anthraxnose* blight affecting *Terminalia* sp, and stem blight and rust affecting Teak.

- Plantation of tissue culture raised clones of Teak was carried out in Randomized Block Design at TFRI, Jabalpur. The clonal trial consisted of total 240 plants of 12 clones. Planted at spacing of 3m × 3m.
- Survival of eucalyptus trial established at Sanmapur Village was found to be 96 %, where as the survival of Bargi adoptive trial was observed to be 26%.
- In *Casuarina* clonal trial established under AICRP-01 at TFRI campus 85% survival was recorded.

### ICFRE- Institute of Forest Genetics & Tree Breeding, Coimbatore

- Population Survey for *Diospyros ebenum* was carried out in Anaimalai Hills, Western Ghats and, Madikeri area, Karnataka. A total of 150 CPTs were identified and individual trees were marked for GBH & height along with GPS reading. Wildlings were collected, kept in nursery for monitoring the growth.
